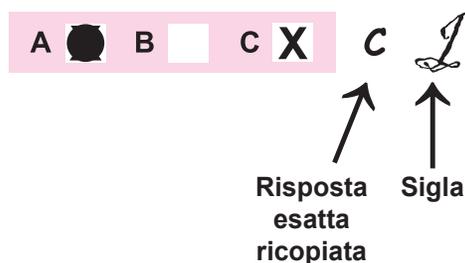

Meet Nathan Hunt

If you travel on the London Underground, you have probably seen a poster of 'Moonlight', the painting, which has brought the artist, Nathan Hunt, to the international scene. I interviewed him in his stone house in the town of Gap in southern France.

It broke my heart to sell 'Goatherd'. But this painting, 'Shepherdess', is not for sale. I will always have it with me in my studio."
