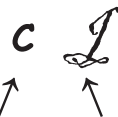

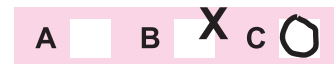

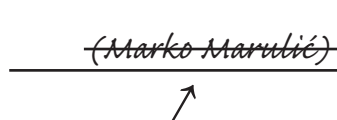

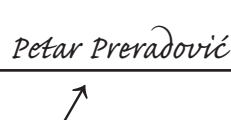

Marcos Demaría was 21 when he left his country, crossing the American border illegally into California. He spoke only Spanish, and surviving in the States wasn't easy for an illegal immigrant. He spent his first days in the streets of Los Angeles with only a few dollars in his pocket, and the first job he took was as a limousine driver for a famous Hollywood actress. He did all sorts of jobs to make ends meet and pay for an English teacher. He knew he had to learn the language to become a success in the States.

He was determined to succeed in the new country and promised himself to become independent before 30. And he did. At 33, he's the most popular dog trainer in the world and his TV programme on handling dogs has become globally famous. It really was a long journey from a small restaurant back home in Mexico, where he earned his first salary cooking local dishes.

Demaría has received several awards. He is extremely proud to be the first Mexican to receive a Treasure Award. At the ceremony, he gave a speech in English and Spanish, when dedicating the award to his parents. He has also received a Special Honor for rehabilitating animals, which is the one he likes most since it was his first award. What's more, he has recently been nominated for an Emmy for Outstanding Reality Program.
